- Date: Saturday 14th September 2019
- Venue: Epworth Hall, Coinagehall Street, Helston, TR13 8EL
- Eligibility: All competitors must be aged 5 years to 7 years on the day of the event and hold a current AJA, BJA or BJC membership which must be shown on the day.
- All competitors must wear a white judogi.
- Categories: All players will be put in groups of 4 based on weights, ages and ratings given by coaches.
- Everyone will receive a medal. The event will be run under AJA rules, no shidos will be given but players will be stopped and rules explained if they infringe them. Contest time 2 minutes.
- All coaches will need to attach a rating to each player of 1-3 (1= needs looking after, 2= average club player , 3= mini ninja). Please answer honestly to ensure the groups are as fair and enjoyable as possible. This is a development and learning event and therefore there will be some junior officials on the day also learning and developing. **There will be no matside coaching, or coaches behind the scoreboards, officials will help players with their belts if needed.**
- Entries limited to 50 Players.
- Weigh In: 09:00 to 09:30am for 10am start.
- Entry Fee: £10 entry fee. Cheques Payable to: **One and All Judo Club**
- Spectator Fee: £2 per person all Spectator Fees will go to Cancer Research UK in memory of Roger Downs.
- Closing date: Monday 9th September 2019 or when entries are full. Entries must be received with payment. No Payment No Entry.
